



Health and Safety Protocols Regarding COVID-19 (as of 7/5/21)

- Each session's maximum capacity is 35 campers. Campers are then divided into smaller, assigned groups for daily activities.
- All campers, staff, and visitors (i.e. parents/family members) will wear masks except when eating lunch/snack and/or when we are outdoors, at which point they will be distanced a minimum of 6' apart.
- Distancing will still be incorporated during activities wherever possible.
- Temperature check and health questionnaire will be conducted upon arrival each day for campers and staff.
- Any campers or staff that are not feeling well should not attend the program that day.
- Bathrooms and activity surfaces will be cleaned & sanitized throughout each camp day.
- Additional disposable masks and sanitizer/sanitizing wipes will be made available throughout the camp facility.
- We will have lunch outdoors at Coe Park when possible, weather permitting.

These health and safety procedures may be updated as we move closer to the start of the Summer Arts Program. We will inform all campers and their parents in the event of any changes/revisions to the above protocols.
